In this course, we will **study The Number System**, **Ratios & Proportional Relationships**, **Expressions & Equations**, **Geometry**, and **Statistics & Probability**. Students are required to complete 45 minutes of iReady math every week with a pass rate of 80% once initial diagnostic testing is completed. (Reviewing notes, handouts, and already solved problems daily will be essential to student achievement.)
