Course Description

In this course, we will **study The Number System, Ratios & Proportional Relationships, Expressions & Equations, Geometry, and Statistics & Probability**. Students will be given many opportunities to practice the skills taught. Assessments will be given weekly. Daily grades will be scored in Google Classroom. Students are required to complete 45 minutes of iReady math every week with a pass rate of 80% once initial diagnostic testing is completed. (Reviewing notes, handouts, and already solved problems daily will be essential to student achievement.)

GCMS Cell Phone Policy

- If a student is found with his/her/their electronic device (which includes wireless earbuds, headphones, & smart watches) inappropriately, a staff member will direct the student to surrender the device – the student will be expected to comply, or face consequences for defiance/noncompliance as defined in the Student Code of Conduct.
